Inpatients with COVID-19 will be allowed 1 caregiver bedside. Caregivers may rotate 1 time per day. Restricted to immediate family within the same household: parent, spouse, significant other and children (16yrs or older). 1 person may stay overnight. Caregivers must remain in patient's room.

| RED<br>LEVEL<br>HIGH TRANSMISSION RISK  | INPATIENT UNITS/<br>ICU/PCU           | 1 designated caregiver at a time. May swap out 1 time per day. 1 may stay overnight.   |
|   | <b>IDU</b><br>INFECTIOUS DISEASE UNIT | 1 designated visitor from 9-11am or 2-4pm.<br>Restricted to immediate family within the same<br>household: parent, spouse, significant other and<br>children (16yrs or older). Exceptions will be made<br>on a case-by-case basis and must be approved by<br>the patient's care team. No overnight stays in IDU. |
|   | LABOR & DELIVERY                      | 2 designated caregivers. May not rotate. 1 may stay overnight.   |
|   | PEDIATRICS                            | 2 designated caregivers that can stay overnight.   |
|   | EMERGENCY<br>DEPARTMENT               | 1 caregiver that must remain in the room at all times and remain for the duration of the ER stay. 2 parents/guardians for pediatric patients.  |
|   | OUTPATIENTS                           | 1 designated caregiver at a time that must remain for the duration of the outpatient visit.  |
